



EvalGender+ call for proposals

EvalGender+ is launching a second round of the call for proposals to provide seed funding for current or upcoming knowledge generation connected to equity-focused and gender responsive (EFGR) evaluations. The proposed funding is to be used in 2021 and consists of **4 grants of USD 2,500 each.**

The main objective is to identify and foster innovation for knowledge generation that can be used to advocate for more EFGR evaluation in the context of the SDGs, to enrich the evaluation field.

EG+ will support selected submitters and winners by:

- Publicizing winners and connecting with submitters from the same countries and regions.
- Publication of article as part of the [Evidence Stories](#) initiative
- The four (4) winners will be able to present at a Webinar with one of the EG+ members and UN Women representative.
- 1 award for travel to an international conference.

The main criteria for selection of proposals by EG+MG would include:

- Innovation: proposals should bring a new lens to EFGR evaluation for SDGs.
- Link to [EvalGender+ mission.](#)
- Quality: the proposal should be based on existing evidence, and provide a clear roadmap for use of the results.
- Non-previous exposure: the presenter should not have had the possibility to present this work in conferences yet.

Considerations

- Eligibility: Individuals representing a Voluntary Organization for Professional Evaluation
- Grant: The grant can be used towards research and data collection (survey, paper, etc) including a roundtable for an upcoming conference
- Deadline for submission: 31 July 2021
